

Montecon Invests to Improve the Competitiveness of Port of Montevideo

The project consists of the design and creation of two mobile cranes capable of reaching 21 rows of containers. The company celebrated the important investment by introducing machines never seen before in terms of port logistics in Uruguay. The Port of Montevideo is the only deep-water port in the country and the region, and it represents a future full of opportunities. The units, whose height is 57.4 meters (188.32 ft), were developed at Montecon's request to overcome the obstacle of not being able to count on gantry cranes capable of meeting the requirements of large vessels.
