Considerations for the Restart of Cruise

- Crew and Passenger Health
 - ✚ Vaccination
 - ✚ Entry / Exit
 - ✚ Adequate testing capacity for COVID-19 infection on board or in cooperation with shore-based laboratories
 - ✚ Arrangements for quarantine of close contacts
 - ✚ Arrangements for isolation of asymptomatic / pre-asymptomatic travellers (passengers or crew with positive test results)
 - ✚ High Risk Groups
- Passenger and Crew Repatriation
 - ✚ Arrangements for medical treatment, ambulance services and where necessary MEDEVAC
 - ✚ Arrangements for Repatriation

Considerations for the Restart of Cruise

- Excursions
 - ✚ Exclusion Policy Information
 - ✚ Port Readiness
 - ✚ Health State of the Country
 - ✚ Readiness of Attractions
- Ports of Call:
 - ✚ Monitoring of epidemiological situations, rules and restriction for the Island of Jamaica and Caribbean Region (in particular, ports of call before calling on Jamaica)
- Hygiene – Cruise, Port, Attractions
 - ✚ Air treatment
 - ✚ Social distance plan
 - ✚ Sanitizing, Cleaning, Disinfecting

Essential Pre-Requisites

Estimation of maximum number of passengers and crew on board cruise ship

Contingency plan/outbreak management plan for responding to a COVID-19 communicated / discussed to the MOHW

Port Protocols congruent to with the cruise line / ship contingency / outbreak management plan

Induction. Sensitization and Training of Crew about COVID-19

Commitment for immediate reporting to the next port of call of any possible cases of COVID-19

Focused inspection on COVID-19 prevention controls for resuming cruise ship voyages as per agreed standards and guidelines (eg. EU Healthy Gateways)

Develop and execute a plan of action to respond to the threat presented by COVID-19.

Prompt identification and isolation/quarantine of employees who have COVID-19 like symptoms.

Review guidelines and protocols established by the Ministry of Health and Wellness (MOHW)

Ensuring the safety of employees

- Strict hygiene measures
- Identifying essential operations / activities
- Identifying the person responsible for these operations / activities
- Procuring personal protective equipment (PPE).
- Ensuring the appropriate actions are taken

Adequate Procedures

Ensure that the port facilities could manage a suspected case without panic, ensure proper containment

Standardized set of procedures and protocols

Prompt testing – development of a “Workplace Call Log Template”.

Isolation and Quarantine

Isolation Rooms on Cruise Terminals

Arrangement between Cruise Ship Operators / Local Private Medical Providers

Stakeholder Engagement & Partnership

- **Determine the information needs for Stakeholders and Partners**
 - Health and Safety,
 - Operational Continuity,
 - Commercial and Administrative Stability,
 - Accessibility and Transportation and Ancillary Services.
- **The identification of the optimal communication tool**
 - Digital,
 - Electronic,
 - Audio-visual,
 - Public and External Channels.

Results

- 53 calls approved with conditions
 - Timely review of protocols for cruise lines – to include any updates
 - Established process of approving SHOREX – even in the resilience corridor
 - Restrictions in St James and Trelawny
 - Pre-approved excursions only
 - To destinations where staff is fully vaccinated
 - Concerns for vaccination status of cruise passengers – especially family-oriented cruises
 - Visits permitted to destinations where all staff is vaccinated
 - **Still expect the line to be held to the MOHW Guidelines**
