FOREWORD

Colleagues, this emergency response plan (ERP) is designed to provide comprehensive, practical, and structured guidance for responding to Emergencies in an efficient and effective manner. The ERP is not to be seen as independent from other emergency response documents within the Company. Rather, it embraces critical more detailed business unit plans, and creates a mechanism for integration and collaboration among all the Company's response teams.

This ERP contains the measures and protocols for managing emergencies from within, for communicating with external agencies and for documenting incidents and events to meet specific corporate and regulatory requirements.

The Divisional Manager, Operations, is assigned as the Document Manager, with the responsibility of overseeing updates and revisions to this document. Please refer to the section "Version Change Control" for more information on how this process will be managed.

I fully expect that there will be full communication of this plan throughout the organization and that the requisite time will be allocated for training and drills to ensure that we are fully prepared for any emergency event.


