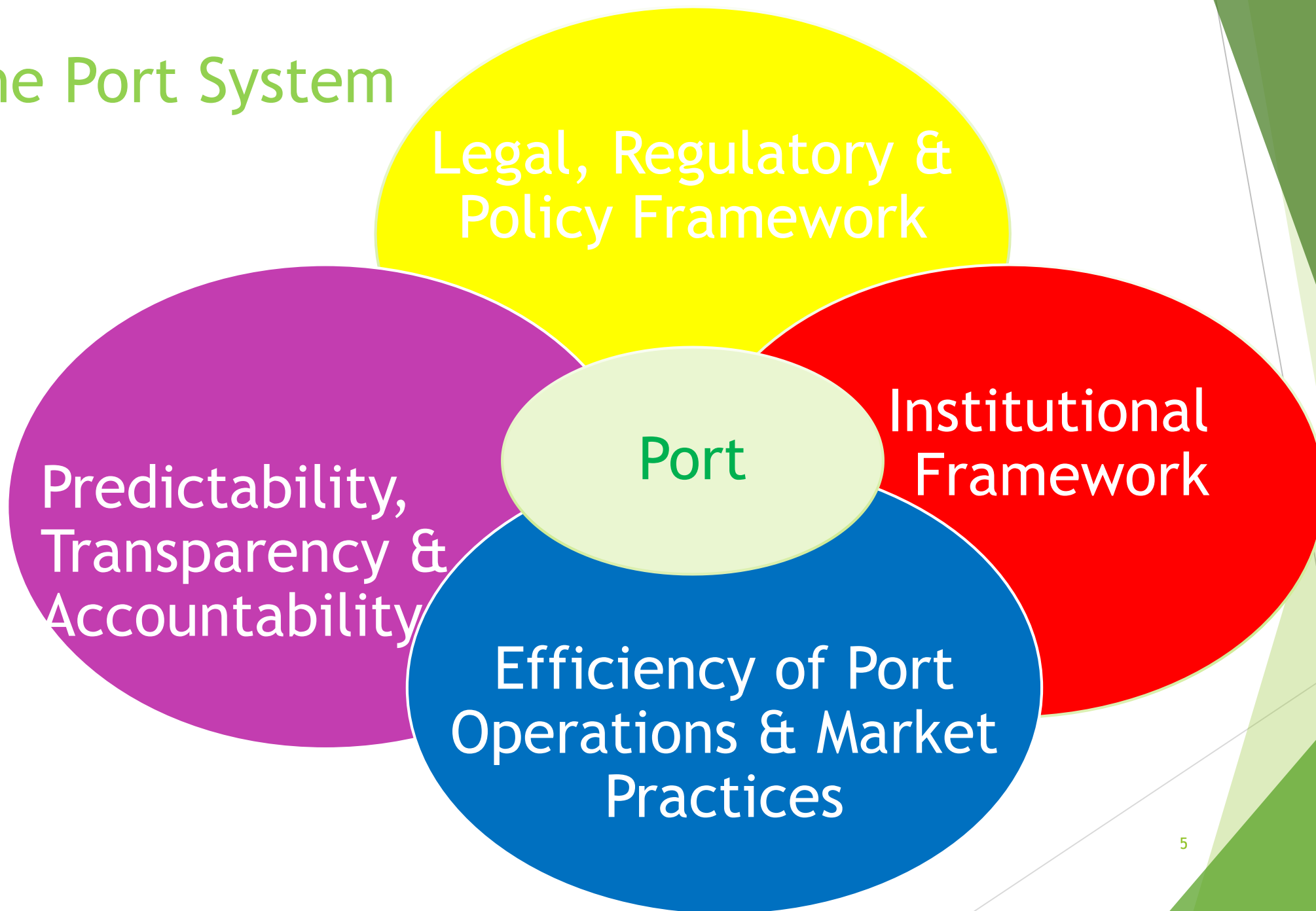

  - ▶ OAS/CIP: compendium on port legislation of the Americas

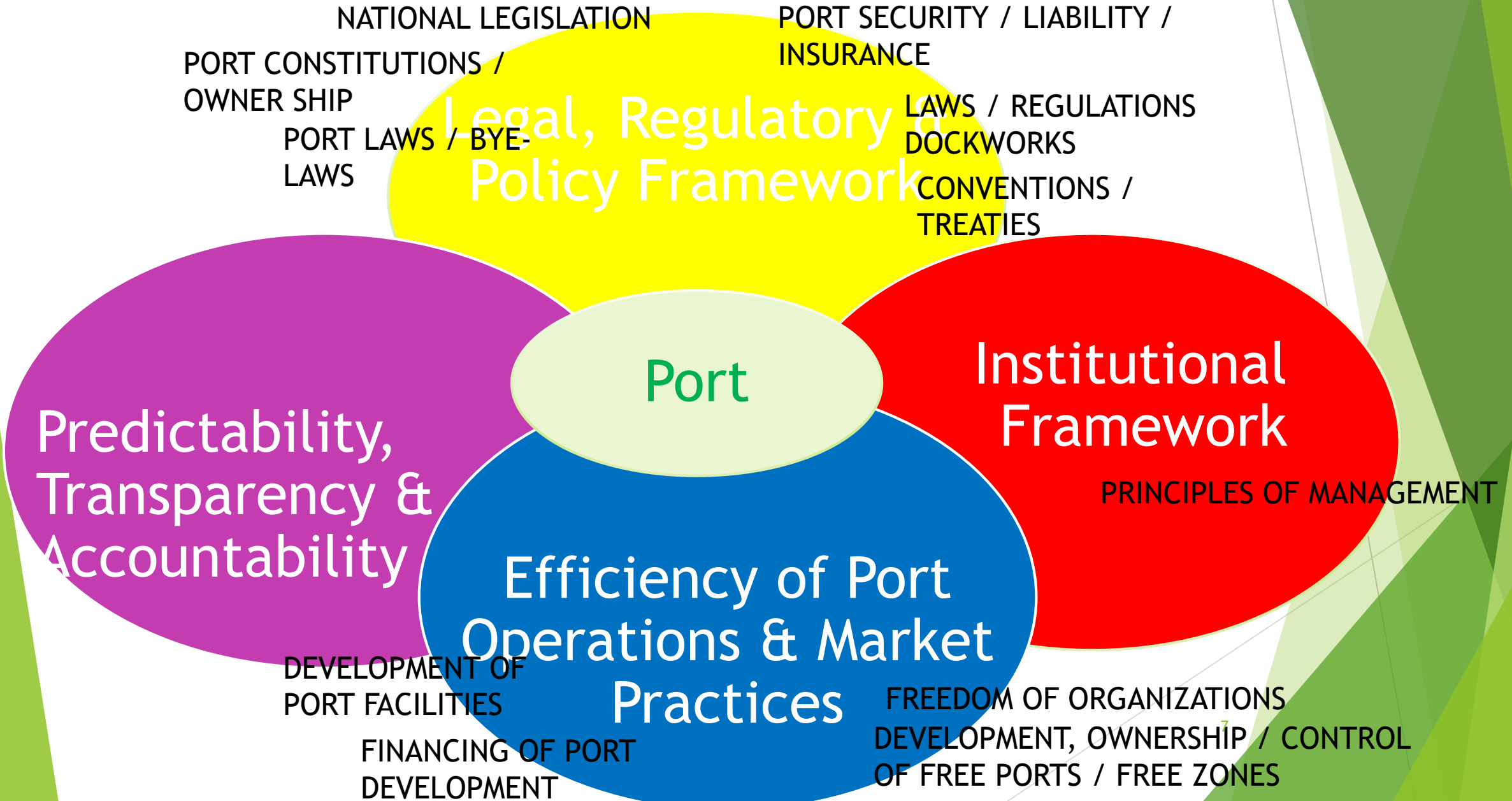

  - ▶ Human resource development

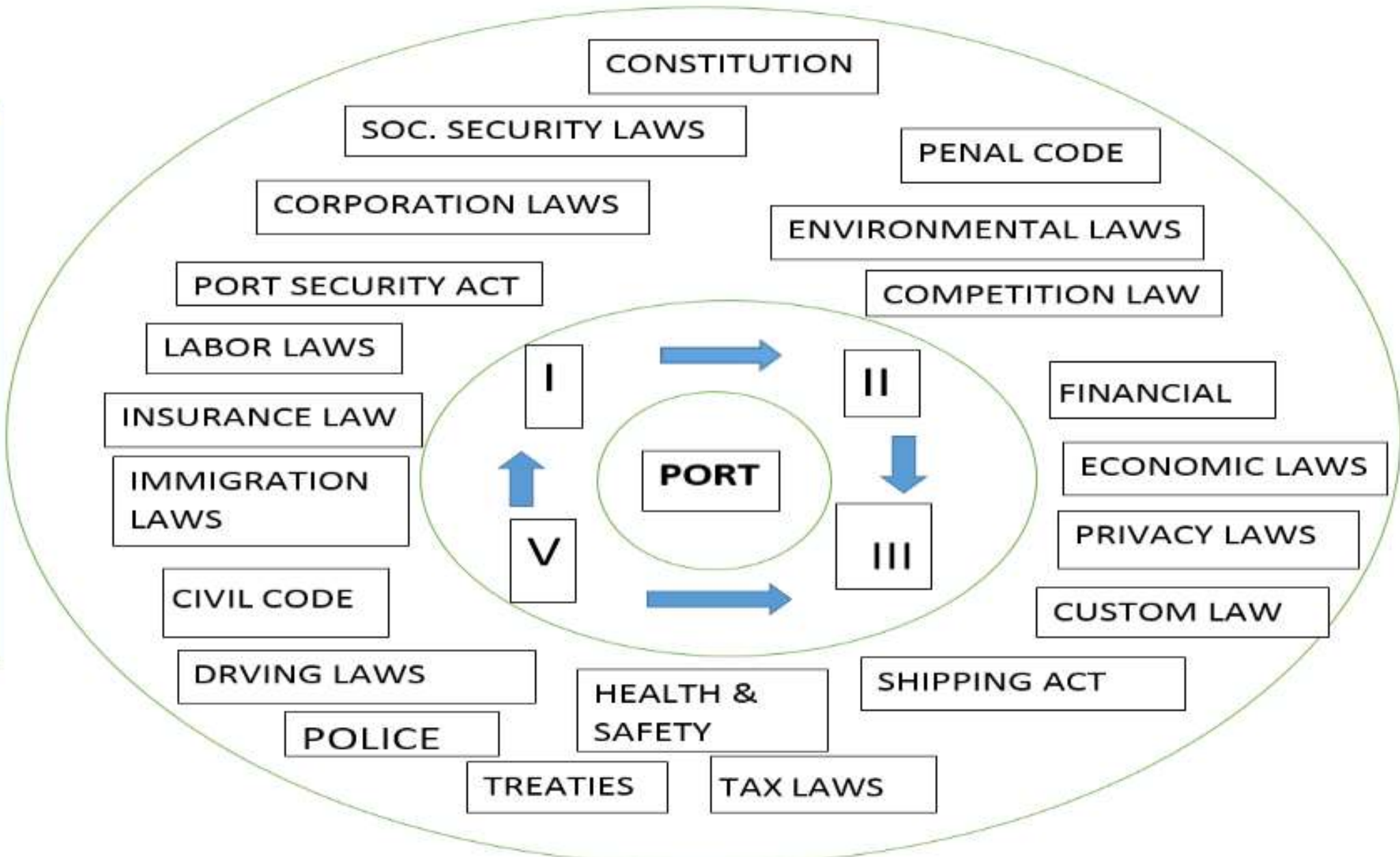
