Online Course “Port and Shipping Management”

Main objective: Provide participants with specific knowledge of maritime transport and port activity, involving a general practical training on maritime and port activity to understand the basic economic mechanisms of the shipping and port business.

Specific objectives:

- a) Name the main actors in the maritime activity and explain how supply and demand in maritime transport behave and interact
- b) Explain the structure of the shipping and port business
- c) Analyze (explain and classify) the main travel costs

Teaching Method: It will be taught online through the platform *Campus Portuario Virtual (CPV)* of the National Port Authority (APN) of Peru. The course will be divided into four weekly modules: Three learning modules with interactive live classes and partial evaluations at the end of each one; and the fourth one for the presentation and/or final project. The learning modules will consist of: PowerPoint presentations, Course Manual, virtual discussion forums, brief readings and videos to complement the classes.

The course instructor will join the participants weekly during the discussion forums and will be available **twice a week (1.5 hours a day) from 6:00 pm to 7:30 pm (Perú time GMT -5)**, to answer participants' questions.

Content:

Module 1: Shipping Management.

Module 2: Port Management.

Module 3: Multimodal transport.

Bachelor's Degree in Maritime Economics - Universidad Argentina de la Empresa (1995-2000), Master's Degree in Logistics Management - Universidad Católica Argentina (2001), MBA - Master's Degree in Business Administration - Escuela de Negocios de la Universidad Argentina de la Empresa (2003-2004), Postgraduate Degree in Port Management and Planning - Fundación Valenciaport (2006), Research Professor - Universidad de Buenos Aires (2011), Master's Degree in Business and Organizational Psychology - Universidad de Belgrado (2018).

Also, Director of the career "Specialization in Maritime Interests" - Instituto Universitario Naval (Since 2006), Executive Secretary of the Foundation "Escuela Nacional de Náutica General Manuel Belgrano" (Since 2010), Advisor to the Undersecretary of Ports and Waterways - National Directorate of River and Maritime Transport (2009-2016), Professor at the "Escuela Nacional de Náutica General Manuel Belgrano", Universidad de la Defensa - Facultad de la Armada, Escuela de Guerra Naval (Maritime Economy, Maritime Interests, Shipping Administration, Port Management, STCW Manila Update, among others).

Requirement: Applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- Be a citizen or permanent resident of a Member State of the OAS.
- Have a title of higher education, preferably, but not exclusively, in the area related to the Port Sector.
- Practice as a specialist in an administration or Port Authority of a Member State of the OAS, performing a technical-operative or managing position.
- Be nominated by a National Port Authority or an Associate Member of the CIP as a candidate for the course. Independent applications cannot be considered in the selection process.
- Participants must be proficient in English. In case it is not the first language, participant must present an academic certificate that endorses it.
- Have knowledge in computing at user level (Word, Excel and PowerPoint, among others).
- Have a computer with Internet access and speakers, as well as any suitable program to watch videos (Quick Time, Windows Media Player, among others).

Note: The scholarships are preferably oriented to applicants who have not received a CIP OAS scholarship in the last year, unless there are vacancies available.

Documents required: Each applicant must submit to the CIP Secretariat the following documents, which together represent the application to participate in the course, by e-mail to Sabina Malnis (smalnis@oas.org) Cc: cip@oas.org , before **Wednesday, September 9th 2020**. **Incomplete applications won't** be taken into consideration for the selection process.

1. Application form (attached) with the required information;
2. Passport copy or official ID from an OAS Member State;
3. Proof of secondary, technical and / or professional studies (in process or completed);
4. Letter of commitment issued by the Direct Supervisor or Director of the applicant's area, addressed to the CIP Secretariat, in which it indicates that it endorses the candidate's application to take the online course;
5. In case of not speaking English as first language, submit a language certificate.

Selected applicant responsibilities: As soon as the applicants have been notified that they have been selected, they must register online, with the technical instructions that the S / CIP will share in the Course Guide. Those selected will be contacted directly by the APN of Peru with the Course Guide and registration instructions to the platform.

Certificate of Participation: Participants who have successfully completed the course will receive a diploma issued by the National Port Authority of Peru and the Inter-American Committee on Ports (CIP) of the OAS.
