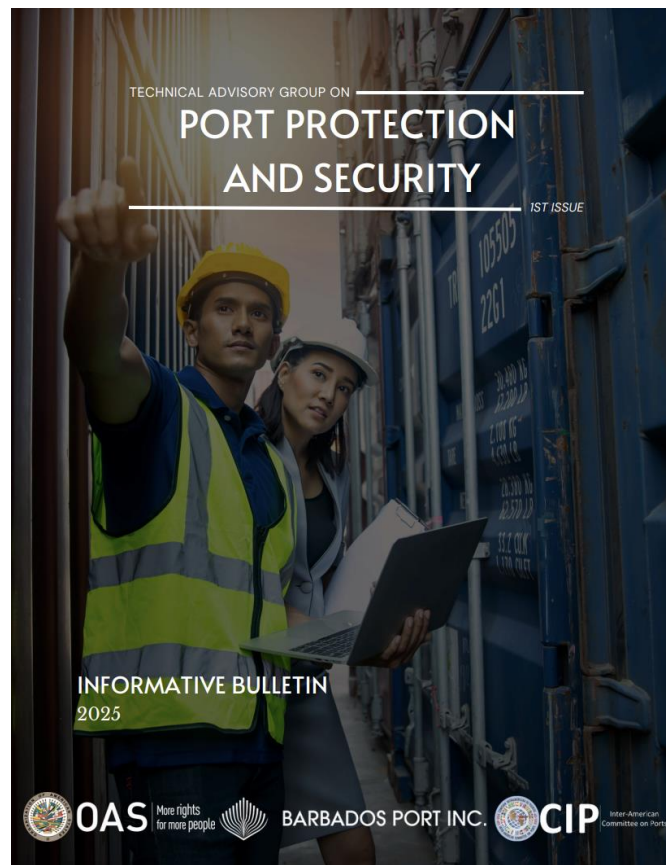
6th Hemispheric Conference on Sustainable Port Management and Environmental Protection
